

# **VOLUNTEERING IN GREECE** REGULATION AND SUPPORT

#### THE GREEK LAW ON VOLUNTEERING



In Greece there is no definition by law for volunteering and volunteers. The only available definition comes from the Hellenic Federation of Non-Governmental Organizations and states that: Volunteering is the willing commitment of an individual to work without pay for a fixed or indefinite period of time for the general good of society. Any legal disputes that arise in relation to volunteers or voluntary organizations are generally dealt with on a case-by-case basis. http://www.opengov.gr/ypes/?p=2455

#### NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF NGOS AND VOLUNTEERING

As part of the state effort to promote and strengthen volunteerism, several activities have been carried out. The most important are: - In June 1999, the Greek Parliament by law established a framework for cooperation between international non-governmental organizations and the

- The development of volunteering is one of the priorities of the Ministry of Health and Welfare. In this context, Law 2646/98 was passed in 1998, which deals with the promotion of volunteering initiatives to the elderly, offering them the opportunity to play an active role as volunteers and to promote volunteering services in the field of welfare. In addition, a department has been established in this Ministry that focuses on volunteering and nongovernmental organizations and is responsible both for the promotion and implementation of voluntary programs and for their evaluation and funding.
- The General Secretariat for Youth implements special volunteering programs, open to young people aged 18–30.
- The Department of International Development and Cooperation of the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs in collaboration with the Greek Doctors Without Borders and the organization KESSA DIMITRA have created the first humanitarian portal (www.anthropos.gr), which is connected with the implementation of the program "Society in Internet for the Promotion of Volunteering "and aims to strengthen volunteering and improve the role of Greek non-governmental organizations.
